## Provision of the standing orders of the Governing Body regarding nominations:

## Clause 8.5

- a) The Registrar shall, as soon as may be, require every subscriber to make a nomination in either of two alternative forms given below according as the subscriber is with or without a family.
- b) A nomination made in Form II shall become null and void soon as a subscriber acquires a family.
- c) As soon as a subscriber acquires a family he shall send to the Registrar a revised nomination in Form I, and formally cancel his previous nomination.
- c) A nomination may be cancelled at any time and substituted by another which would be permissible to make under the provision of this rule.
